SUMMER ELECTIONS

In case you haven't heard – we got a President to re-elect this year and a tyrant to be defeated. But first we have local elections and state and national primaries to be aware of:

August 1 is the County General and State Primary. In Shelby County, we will be electing the General Sessions Court Clerk – Tami Sawyer (D) vs Lisa Arnold (R). This is the one race that is held independently of all the other county races.

In Shelby County primaries will also be held on August 1 for US Congress, US Senate, all State House seats and 2 of our State Senate seats. Several club members are running in these primaries including Rep Steve Cohen (TN 9), Noah Norstrom (House 83), Gabby Salinas (House 96) and Jesse Huseth (House 97). In addition, we will be electing School Board members, a judge in Germantown, and selected positions in some of our suburban cities. Also, in parts of Collierville and further reaches of the county, you will be electing a male representative to the TNDP Executive Committee.

Remember, Vote Democrat and always ask for a Democratic primary ballot. Although we do not endorse in contested primaries, both Jesse Huseth and Noah Nordstrom are running uncontested and will be our Democratic candidates in November. We endorse both. Get involved and support our candidates!!
